SPECIAL TIP:

If you want to combine Vienna and Bratislava the TWIN CITY LINER is a good way to travel between the two geographically closest capitals in the world. It is a catamaran which arrives and departs directly in the city centres and is one of the fastest methods of transport on the Danube. The travelling time is only 1 hour 15 minutes and offers fascinating views of the river.



Short stay BRATISLAVA

DAY 1

Arrivals at Bratislava airport or train station, check-in to centrally located **** hotel, dinner in local restaurant with typical Slovakian food (3 courses, water, coffee).

DAY 2

Bratislava city tour to discover the city's most important sights such as Grassalkovich Palace, the National Theatre and Bratislava Castle: from there enjoy a fantastic panoramic view to the historical centre. Drive along the Danube to the ruins of Devin Castle, situated above the confluence of the Danube and Morava which was during the time of the Iron Curtain the border between West and East.

Long stay BRATISLAVA

DAY 1

Arrivals at Bratislava airport or train station, check-in to centrally located **** hotel, dinner in local restaurant with typical Slovakian food (3 courses, water, coffee).

DAY 2

Bratislava city tour to discover the city's most important sights such as Grassalkovich Palace, the National Theatre and Bratislava Castle: from there enjoy a fantastic panoramic view to the historical centre. Drive along the Danube to the ruins of Devin Castle, situated above the confluence of the Danube and Morava which was during the time of the Iron Curtain the border between West and East.

DAY 3

Jewish Bratislava: Visit Bratislava's Jewish sights and get to know the history of this once important community. You will see Chatam Sofer's tomb and visit the Museum of Jewish Culture which displays a varied and detailed collection of artefacts representing Jewish everyday life. You will see where the ghetto was situated and have a look at the Holocaust memorial wall and a picture of the ruined synagogue. The tour ends with a visit to the only remaining synagogue in Bratislava (not on Saturdays).

DAY 4: B

Tour to the Lesser Carpathian mountain region which has been known for its wine since Roman times. You will see the ancient royal wine towns Pezinok and Modra. There you will stop at a local pottery to see how the famous Slovak Folk Majolica is produced. The highlight of the tour is the visit to Cerveny Kamen a wonderfully preserved castle with multi-storey cellars where you can taste some of the local wines.
